The Chancery	<b>World Youth Day 2027 Expressions of Interest Now Open</b>  Sandhurst Youth Ministry (SYM) is now accepting <i>Expressions of Interest</i> for our pilgrimage to WYD Seoul, South Korea, August 2027. If you feel called to be part of this once-in-a-lifetime journey of faith, community, and encounter and are between the ages of 18 and 35, we invite you to take the first step! Estimated cost is between \$6,200 and \$8,500. After subsidies, the estimated cost to individual pilgrims will be <b>\$2000 - \$3000</b> . Final cost is dependent on multiple factors. Scan the QR Code and fill out the EOI form to receive more information and updates.  Completing the EOI does not lock you in or guarantee you a spot but assists SYM in the planning of the pilgrimage and will contribute to the final recommendation to Bishop René Ramirez RCJ followed by an official pilgrimage launch in the second half of 2026.
